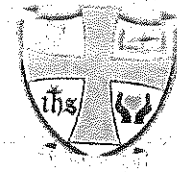

This book will help your child continue to listen to rhyming words. After you read the book, help your child write 25 sets of rhyming words from the book.

(not family words. For example why and high are rhyming words. Fan and ran are family words.)
