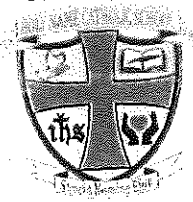

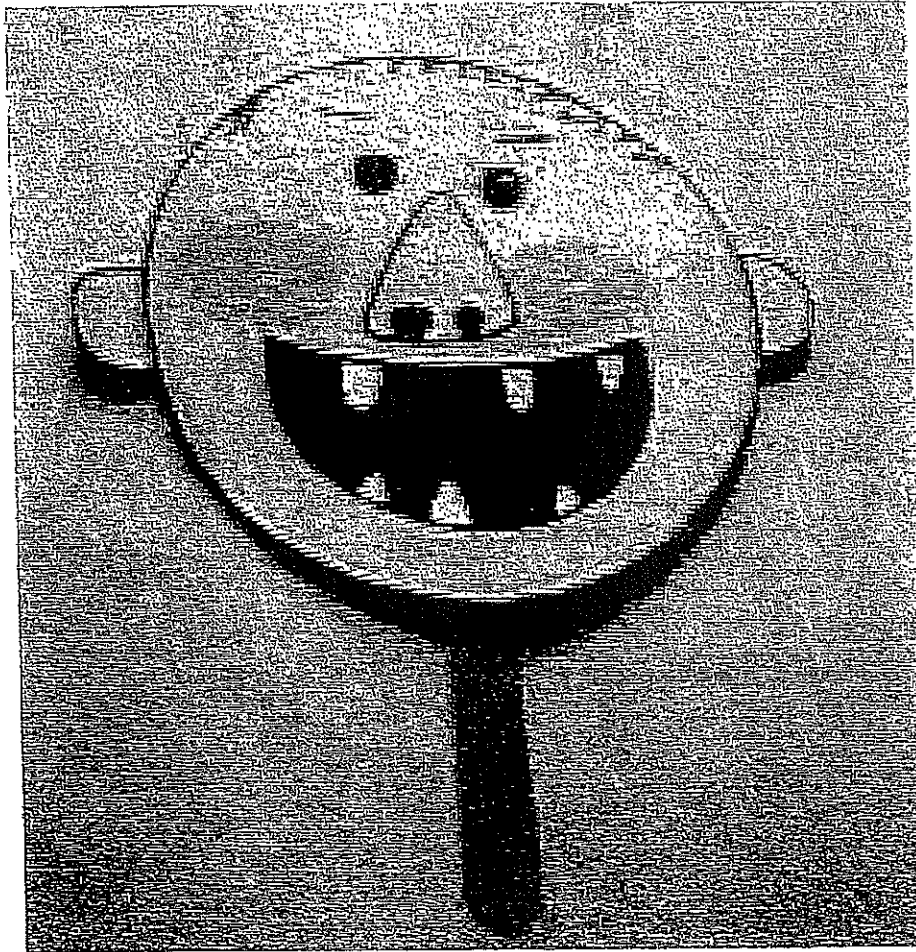
About This Book

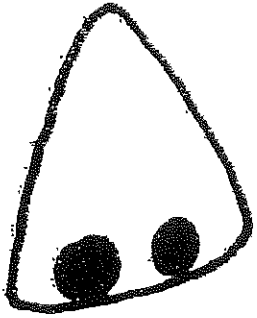
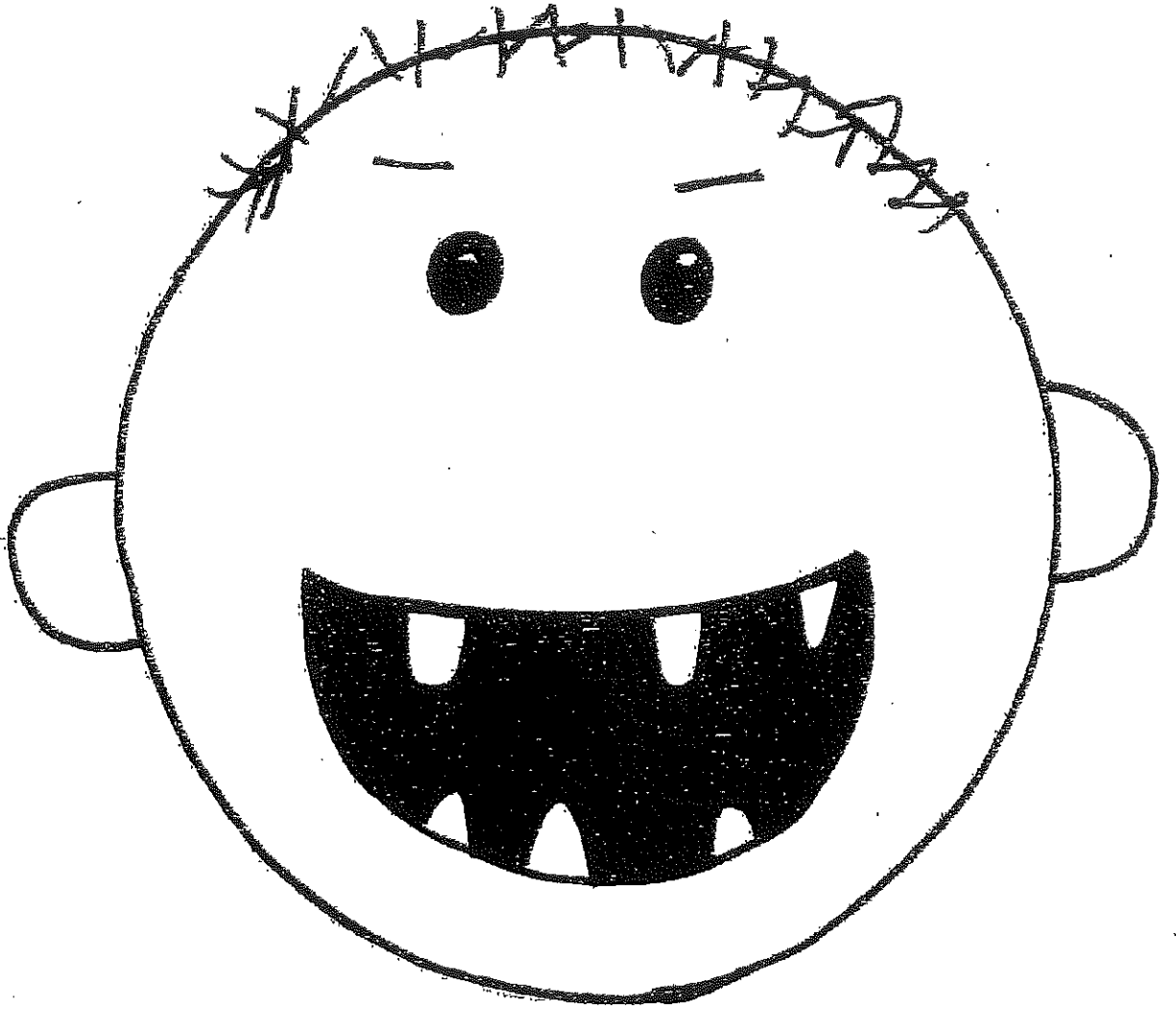

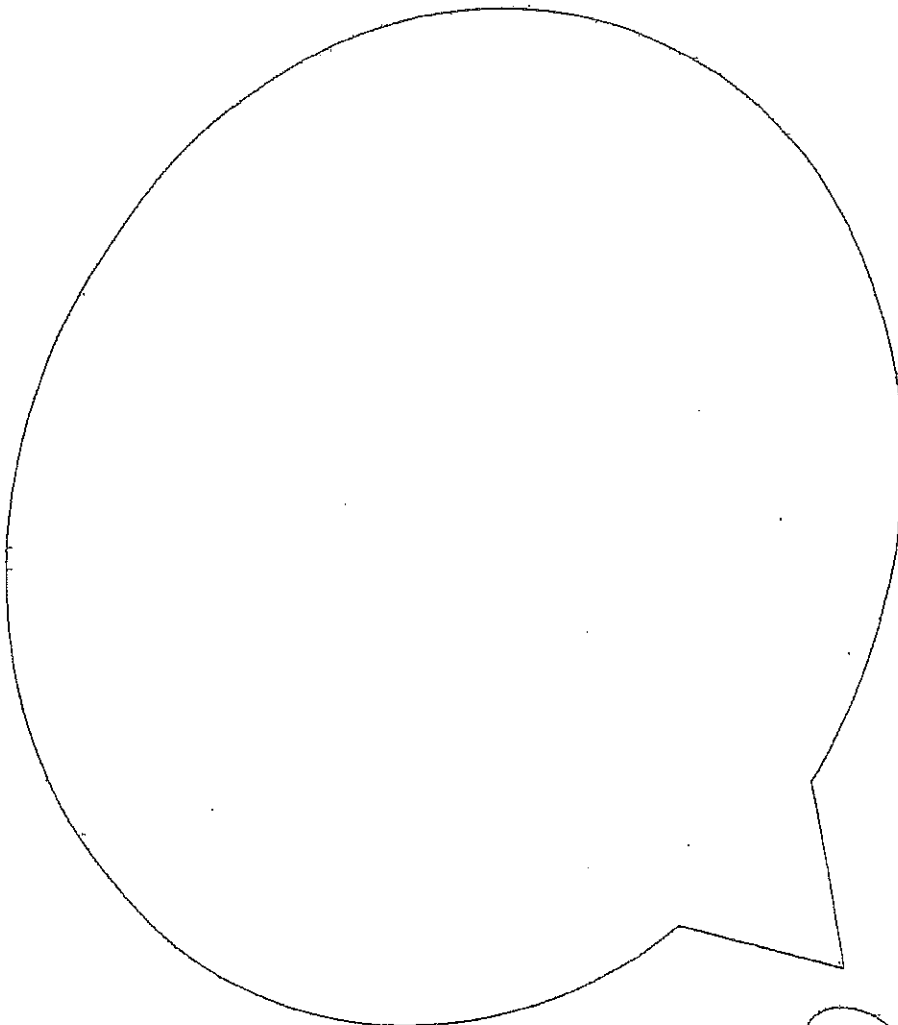

doing activities the first week of school using your child's completed projects. Hope you have a safe and blessed summer.

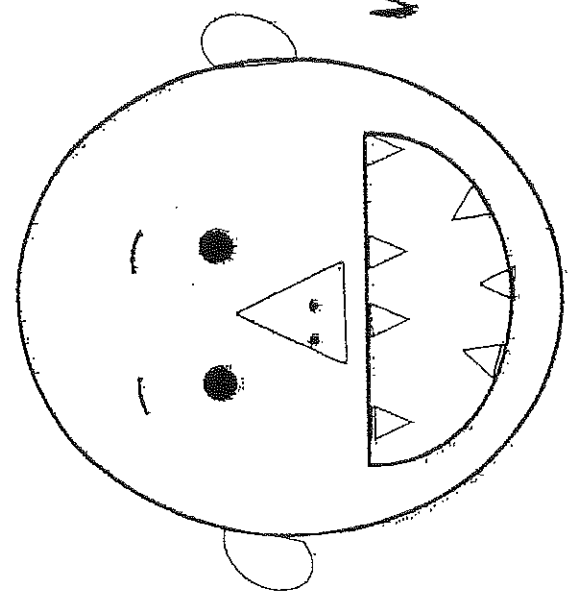

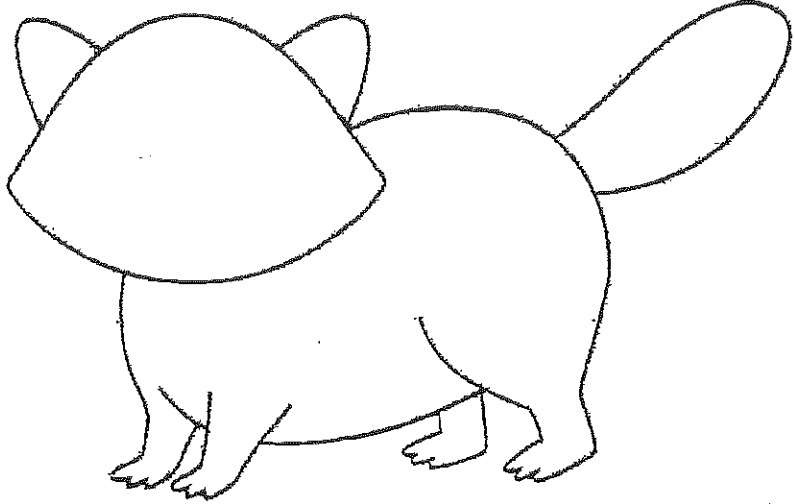

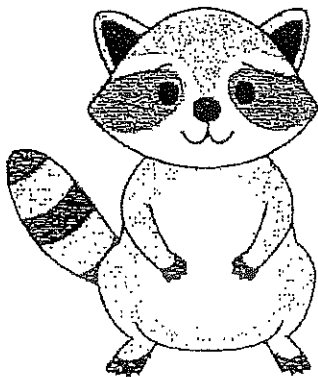

The Kissing Hand Craftivity

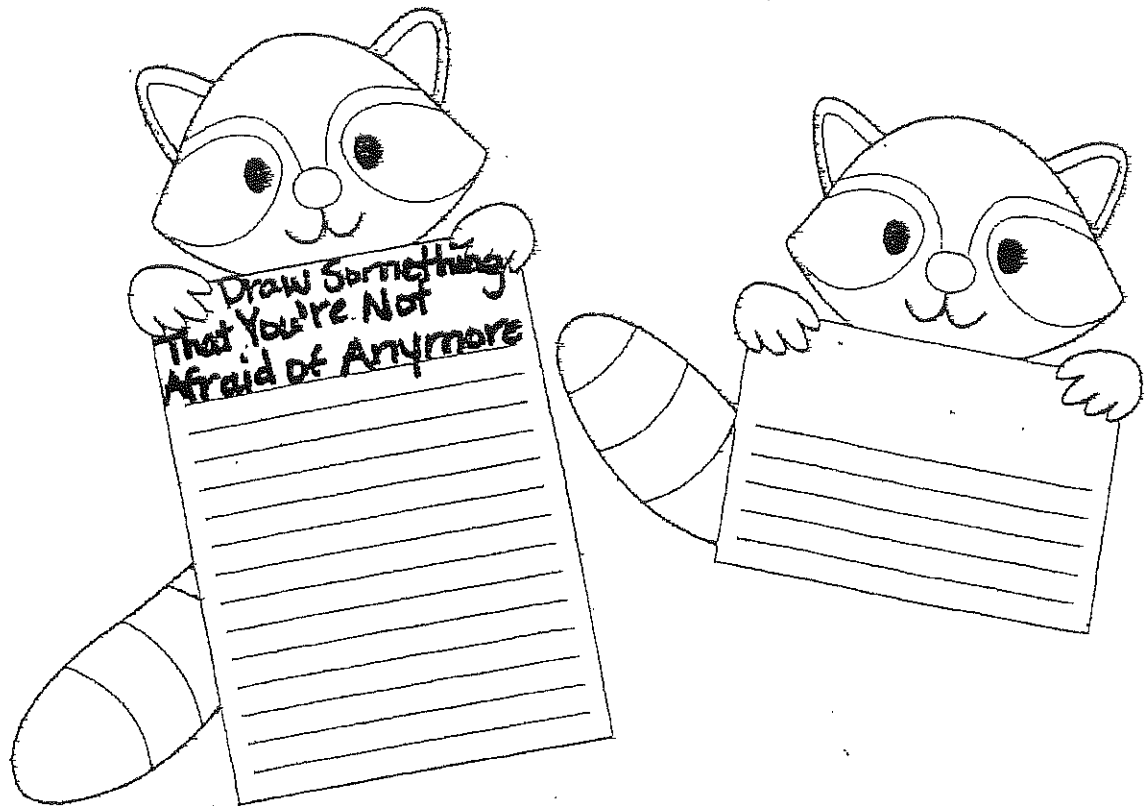
It's time to get crafty!

Now your Kissing Hand Craftivity is complete!

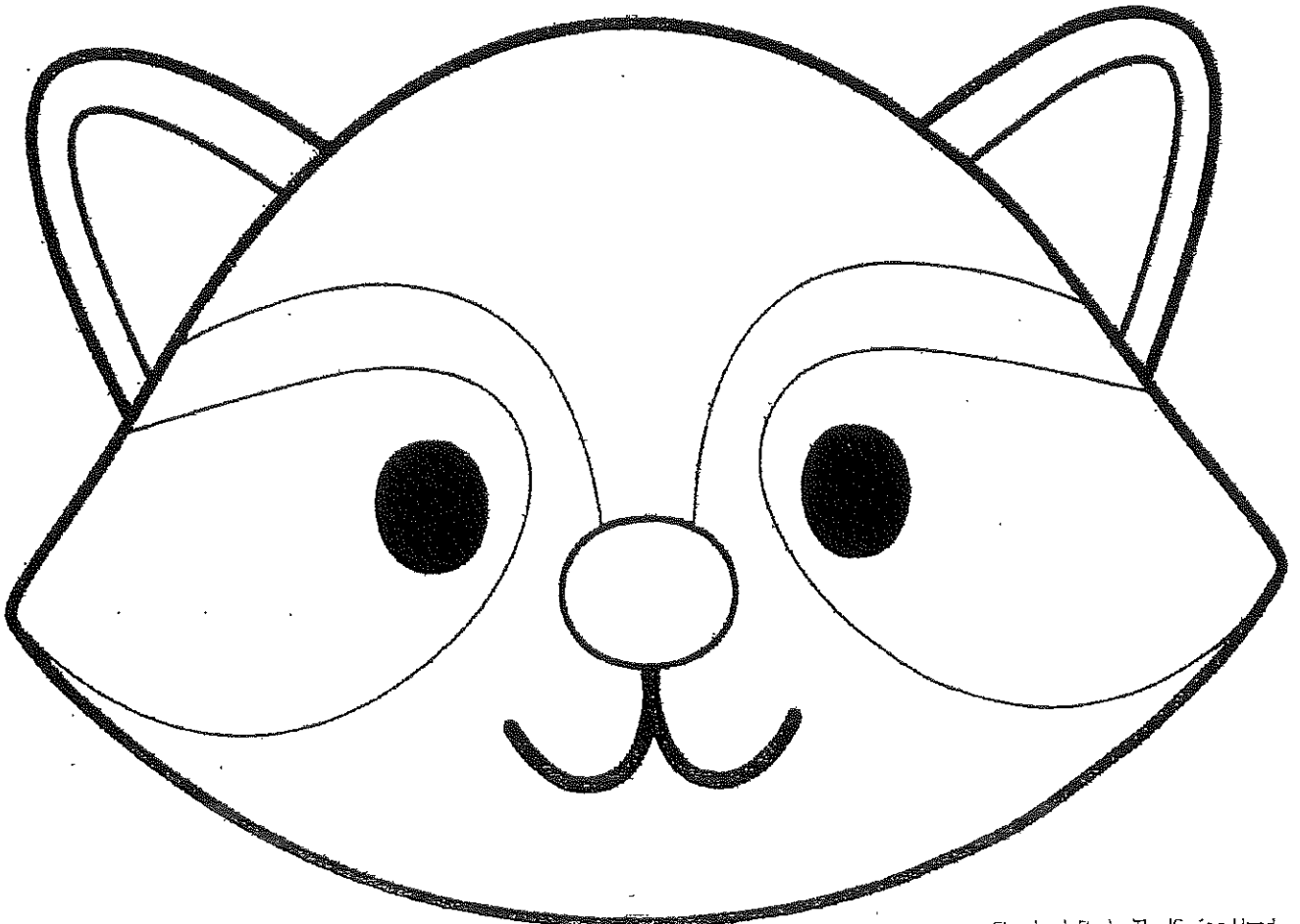
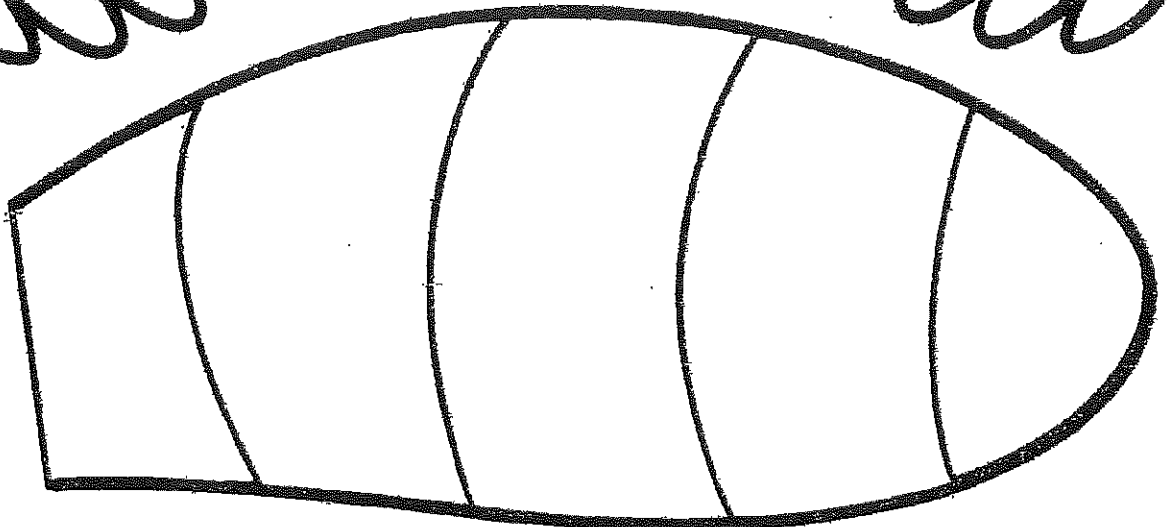
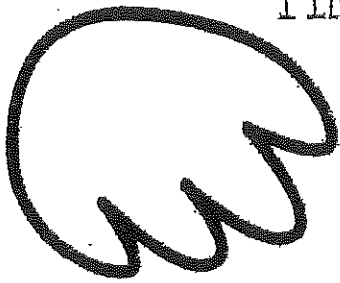
